SCENE
ONE

We float along the glistening waterfront, past sidewalk cafes, and CLOSE IN on the familiar sign for the "Fowey Festival."

Up ahead, tents are being erected.

In the midst of preparations, we find Isabelle calling out to someone, unseen, in the back.

ISABELLE

You secured a luncheon with Dylan Turner?

Joss walks out, holding a box of books to display.

JOSS

I know the kids are really excited he's reading so I wanted to make the most of it.

ISABELLE

Between that, and the panel of writers you pulled together. You realize this festival is gonna market itself?

JOSS

I'm just happy I get to do it.

ISABELLE

Not as happy as I am that you came back and wanted to.

They share a sweet smile before-- Isabelle spots someone in the distance. Smirks:

ISABELLE (CONT'D)

Although, I doubt I'm the *most* excited one out here.

Joss follows Isabelle's gaze to the waterfront. In the midst of all the action, she spots--

DANIEL

START

END

DANIEL
You can even make your own puppet
after the puppet show.

TEGAN
Yes!
(to Joss)
Can you come?

Daniel shoots her an apologetic smile.

DANIEL
I'm sure Joss has a lot to do.

Joss nods. Tegan tries to hide her disappointment. Joss
notices, reconsiders:

JOSS
But, considering how it's been
going, maybe a change of scenery
will do me good.
(beat)
Think I can be back in an hour?

Tegan smiles, ecstatic. Daniel nods.

DANIEL
I think we can arrange that.

Joss and Daniel share a smile.

Nearly but unseen, Merryn sees the three of them heading for
Daniel's car, a look of unease washing over her.

51 EXT. FARMER'S MARKET - DAY

51 SCENE
TWO

A colorful, popular farmer's market -- pastry, cheese and
used book stalls visible. In the center of it all, we find
Joss, Tegan, LILY (8), Felix and his wife, ISABELLE (30s),
all watching the end of the PUPPET SHOW.

Kids and adults, fully entertained. As they finish up,
everyone claps. Joss is in shock:

START

JOSS
I can't believe I almost didn't get
to see that. They were amazing!

START

DANIEL
(jokes)
And not at all creepy?

JOSS
No. Okay, maybe a little.

They share a laugh before-- Felix shuffles over:

FELIX
You must be... the American.

DANIEL
(to Felix)
I did tell you her name.
(playfully apologetic)
Joss, this is Felix. Felix, Joss.

ISABELLE
(heads over)
And his incredibly tolerant wife,
Isabelle.

Felix gives Isabelle a kiss in agreement.

JOSS
Nice to meet you, both.

DANIEL
Isabelle actually handles all the
marketing for the Fowey Festival.

ISABELLE
(jokes)
Let's hope you've heard of it?

JOSS
My mom used to go, as a child,
loved listening to all the poets
and writers.

DANIEL
And clearly passed it on. Joss is a
professor of literature. So,
connection.

Off their curiosity, clarifies:

JOSS
Romantic literature. Although
oddly, this is my first time here.

ISABELLE
England or Cornwall?

JOSS
Both.

ISABELLE

Then I'm assuming you've never
tried a Cornish pasty.

JOSS

A what?

FELIX

Translation: A savory, flaky hand-
pie.

DANIEL

All your veg and meat in one go.
Miners used to wrap it a towel and
take it down with them.

JOSS

Sounds filling.

Tegan and Lily run over.

LILY

Can we get a biscuit instead?

FELIX

Of lunch? No.

TEGAN

What about a toffee apple?

DANIEL

Now that's a different story.

Felix and Isabelle shoot him a look.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

Kidding. We can talk dessert after
we get you some real food.

(to all)

Who's hungry?

With that, they head to the Cornish pasty stall. Joss is
soaking it all in.
